**IN RE: HB1660** by Capriglione (Relating to the process for notifying the attorney general of a breach of security of computerized data by persons doing business in this state.), **As Introduced**

The bill would amend the Business & Commerce Code relating to the process for notifying the Office of the Attorney General of a breach of security of computerized data by persons doing business in this state.

According to the Office of the Attorney General, any additional workload created by the provisions of this bill could be absorbed within current resources.
