IN RE: HB2120 by Bell, Keith (Relating to the practice of barbering and cosmetology at an establishment at a public secondary school.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

School districts that chose to establish a license to practice barbering and cosmetology could offset costs by earning revenue.
