**IN RE: HB3102** by Lambert (relating to the cancellation of certain consumer transactions.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

**No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.**

The bill would amend the Business and Commerce Code regarding the cancellations of a consumer transactions as well as the merchant's compensation when a consumer's transactions is cancelled.

It is assumed that any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed using existing resources.
