IN RE: HB3102 by Lambert (Relating to the cancellation of certain consumer transactions.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Business and Commerce Code regarding the cancellations of a consumer transactions as well as the merchant's compensation when a consumer's transactions is cancelled.

According to the Office of the Attorney General, any additional work resulting from the provisions of the bill could be absorbed within current resources.
