IN RE: HB3315 by Bell, Keith (Relating to a school district's grievance procedure regarding complaints concerning violation of parental rights.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

It is assumed that any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed using existing resources.

Local Government Impact

This bill would require school districts and open-enrollment charter schools to implement a model grievance policy created by the Texas Education Agency. School districts and charter schools would be required to provide information on their website regarding a parent's right to file a complaint. However, no significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
