IN RE: HB3327 by Wu (Relating to the confidentiality of certain home address information in property tax appraisal records.), As Introduced

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend Chapter 25 of the Tax Code to expand the confidentiality of home addresses in appraisal records to include an employee of a public defender's office.
