IN RE: HB3370 by Vasut (Relating to authorizing certain physical therapists to serve as a treating doctor under the workers' compensation system.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

Based on the analysis of the Department of Insurance, Texas Medical Board, and the Executive Council of Physical and Occupational Therapy Examiners, any duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by utilizing existing agency resources.
