IN RE: HB3436 by Rogers (relating to the authority of the Texas Military Department to negotiate the release of a reversionary interest and certain other interests of the state in certain property in Palo Pinto County owned by the Palo Pinto County Livestock Association.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would direct the Texas Military Department (TMD) to negotiate the release of the state's reversionary and other interest in certain property located in Palo Pinto County. According to TMD, any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed using existing resources.
