**IN RE: HB3782** by Guillen (relating to establishing the Border Security Advisory Council and the Border Protection Task Force.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

<b>No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.</b>
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The bill would amend the Government Code relating to establishing the Border Security Advisory Council and the Border Protection Task Force.
