IN RE: HB3803 by Cunningham (Relating to allowing parents and guardians to elect for a student to repeat or retake a course or grade.), **As Engrossed**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

It is assumed that any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed using existing resources.

Local Government Impact

School districts and open-enrollment charter schools would need to update their guidance and training to report when a parent requests a student repeat or retake a high school credit course or grade one through eight. However, no significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
