IN RE: HB4078 by Geren (relating to motor vehicle franchised dealers and the reimbursement of motor vehicle franchised dealers by manufacturers and distributors for warranty, recall, and preparation and delivery work.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend provisions of Occupations Code, Chapter 2301, relating to compensation owed to a motor vehicle dealer for certain warranty, recall, preparation, and delivery work. The bill would establish a process for manufacturers, distributors, and dealers to dispute a dealer's compensation claims.

Based on the information provided by the Texas Department of Motor Vehicles, it is assumed implementation of the bill would not result in a significant fiscal impact to the State.

Local Government Impact

No fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
