IN RE: **HB4264** by Button (relating to the eligibility of the National Reined Cow Horse Association Championship Series for funding under the major events reimbursement program.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

The fiscal implications of the bill cannot be determined at this time. The fiscal impact would depend on the number and size of events covered under the bill.
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The bill would amend the Government Code to include certain events as eligible for funding under the Major Events Reimbursement Program.

According to the Office of the Governor, the fiscal impact of the bill to the state cannot be determined without information from the event organizers' application. This includes the number of attendees and the duration of the event.

Local Government Impact

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
