IN RE: HB4470 by Isaac (Relating to school marshals, including eligibility for appointment as a school marshal, and licensure and training requirements.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

Districts may need to update policies related to marshals if volunteers are allowed to be marshalls.
