IN RE: HB4606 by Allen (Relating to the operation of a juvenile justice alternative education program by a county department of education.), **Committee Report 1st House, Substituted**

No fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Education Code as it relates to the operations of a juvenile justice alternative education program by a county department of education. According to the Texas Juvenile Justice Department, any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed using existing resources.
