**IN RE: SB51** by Zaffirini (Relating to health benefit coverage for hearing aids for children and adults.), **As Introduced**

<b>No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.</b>
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Based on the analysis of the Employees Retirement System, Department of Insurance, Health and Human Services Commission, Texas A&M University System Administrative & General Offices, and the University of Texas System Administration, duties and responsibilities associated with implementing the provisions of the bill could be accomplished by the agencies utilizing existing resources.
