IN RE: SB189 by Miles (Relating to the creation of a criminal offense concerning the failure of certain persons to report abuse, neglect, or exploitation in boarding home facilities.), **As Introduced**

No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would create a Class A misdemeanor offense for certain persons failing to report abuse, neglect, or exploitation in a boarding home facility. It is assumed that any fiscal impact and any impact on state correctional populations or on the demand for state correctional resources would not be significant.

Local Government Impact

It is assumed that any fiscal impact to units of local government associated with enforcement, prosecution, supervision, or confinement would not be significant.
