The bill would require the denial of bail to a person accused of committing certain trafficking or sexual offenses against a child while released on bail for committing a similar offense. The Office of Court Administration (OCA) indicates that no significant fiscal impact to the state court system is anticipated.

**Local Government Impact**

According to OCA, the denial of bail to certain defendants may result in more defendants being detained locally pending trial, which may have a fiscal impact to units of local government.
