IN RE: SB1639 by Zaffirini (Relating to prohibitions in connection with ticket sales on an Internet website; providing a civil penalty.), **As Engrossed**

The bill amends the Business & Commerce to provide prohibitions in connection with event ticket sales or resales on an Internet website. The bill authorizes the Office of the Attorney General to investigate violations and file suits for injunctive relief.

It is assumed that any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed using existing resources.

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
