IN RE: SB2250 by Zaffirini (relating to the execution of a certificate of completion for the purchase of solar panels under a retail installment contract.), Committee Report 1st House, Substituted

### No significant fiscal implication to the State is anticipated.

The bill would amend the Finance Code relating to retail sellers of solar panels and prohibiting them from requiring a retail buyer to execute a certificate unless the solar panels are fully operational and pass the applicable inspection.

It is assumed that any costs associated with the bill could be absorbed using existing resources.

### **Local Government Impact**

No significant fiscal implication to units of local government is anticipated.
