Pursuant to Rule 4, Section 21(a), of the House Rules of Procedure, and Section 301.024 (a), Government Code, I move as follows in connection with MATTER B:

- (1) The issuance of a subpoena is authorized to ROBERT ROE #1 to provide all relevant testimony and information concerning the committee's inquiry
- (2) The committee chair is directed to issue the process authorized by this motion in a form acceptable to the chair. The committee chair may issue one or more subpoenas for a part or portion of any relevant testimony or information as necessary to avoid overburdening a witness or the committee.
- (3) The committee chair is authorized to appoint, on the committee's behalf, a sergeant-at-arms or an agent to serve the authorized process.
