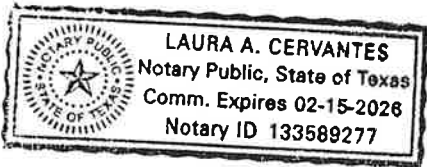

## NOTICE OF INTENTION TO INTRODUCE A BILL IN THE LEGISLATURE OF TEXAS

Notice is hereby given of the intention to introduce in the Regular Session of the 88th Legislature of Texas a bill creating and establishing a special district consisting of approximately 852.43 acres and located within the Blake Brantley Survey, Abstract No. 104, the Gwyn Morrison Survey, Abstract No. 357, the Edley Montgomery Survey, Abstract No. 355, the Samuel New Survey, Abstract No. 365, the Thomas Corner Survey, Abstract Nos. 155 and 167, the William R. Wheelis Survey, Abstract Nos. 480 and 481, and the E.T. Estis Survey, Abstract No. 194, within the extraterritorial jurisdiction of the City of Plantersville, and wholly within Grimes County, Texas, to be known as Grimes County Municipal Utility District No. 3, under the provisions of Article 16, Section 59 of the Constitution of Texas and pursuant to the inherent power of the Legislature to create special governmental agencies and districts, with powers including those given to municipal utility districts operating pursuant to Chapters 49 and 54, Texas Water Code, and including road powers under Article III, Section 52 of the Constitution of Texas. The bill will provide for the district's administration, powers, name, duties, operation, and financing.
