HB 165 Johnson, Ann

Relating to the prosecution of and punishment for an aggravated assault occurring as part of a mass shooting; increasing a criminal penalty.

HB 175 Schaefer

Relating to the expunction of arrest records and files for certain defendants placed on deferred adjudication community supervision for the unlawful carrying of a handgun.

HB 544 Johnson, Julie

Relating to the reporting of certain orders and convictions to the Department of Public Safety and Federal Bureau of Investigation for use with the National Instant Criminal Background Check System for the transfer of firearms.

HB 636 Patterson

Relating to the applicability to election judges of a prohibition on the carrying of a handgun at a polling place.

HB 902 Moody

Relating to prohibiting the transfer of certain firearm magazines to certain recipients; creating a criminal offense.

HB 1229 Harris, Cody

Relating to the collection and confidentiality of information regarding weapons in agency foster homes; creating a civil penalty.

HB 1760 Hefner

Relating to the prosecution of the offense of possessing a weapon in certain prohibited places associated with schools or postsecondary educational institutions.

HB 2076 Goodwin

Relating to the prohibition on the possession of a firearm by a person following the person's conviction of certain family violence misdemeanors.

HB 2242                    Howard  
Relating to the use of dynamic message signs for the Keep 'Em Safe Texas  
Gun Storage Campaign.

HB 2454                    Guillen  
Relating to procuring a firearm for person prohibited to possessing a  
firearm; creating a criminal offense.

HB 2780                    Leach  
Relating to the reporting of mental health and intellectual disability  
information with respect to certain children for purposes of a federal  
firearm background check.

HB 3443                    Canales  
Relating to adding a designation on a person's driver's license or  
commercial driver's license indicating that the person is licensed to  
carry a handgun.

HB 3539                    Troxclair  
Relating to the establishment and administration of a state ammunition  
manufacturing facility; granting rulemaking authority.

HCR 36                    Guillen  
Urging Congress to ensure that the survivors and surviving families of the  
Sutherland Springs mass shooting receive compensation equivalent to the  
relief provided to those impacted by similar incidents.
