HB 1318 Darby  
Relating to the regulation of brine mining wells.

HB 2140 Cunningham  
Relating to the enforcement by the attorney general of rules adopted by  
the Railroad Commission of Texas requiring gas supply chain facility  
operators to implement measures to prepare to operate during a weather  
emergency.

HB 2262 Darby  
Relating to gas utility alternative gas expenses and infrastructure  
investments.

HB 2847 Darby  
Relating to the jurisdiction of the Railroad Commission of Texas over and  
a study of the upstream production, pipeline transportation, and storage  
of hydrogen.

HB 3244 Goldman  
Relating to the operation of certain infrastructure during a weather  
emergency; authorizing administrative penalties.

HB 4046 Guillen  
Relating to the reduction and plugging of orphaned oil and gas wells;  
providing for the imposition of a fee and an exemption from certain taxes  
and fees.

HB 4047 Guillen  
Relating to a study on uranium deposits in this state.

HB 4117 Turner  
Relating to the adequacy of service provided by gas utilities.

HB 4118 Turner  
Relating to service provided to residential customers by certain gas utilities during weather emergencies; authorizing a civil penalty.

HB 4225 Zwiener  
Relating to a study conducted by the Railroad Commission of Texas to determine the net reduction in the amount of carbon dioxide in the atmosphere resulting from the use of carbon capture, utilization, and storage technology.

HB 4790 Anchía  
Relating to the provision of natural gas by and rates charged by certain gas utilities.

HB 4984 Anchía  
Relating to reporting by operators of certain gas supply chain facilities and gas pipeline facilities on a failure to perform a contractual obligation due to a weather emergency.
