Relating to ensuring certain adoptive parents may consent to medical care and access information regarding their child who is eligible for benefits under Medicaid.

Relating to requirements applicable to certain third-party health insurers in relation to Medicaid.

HB 3265 Manuel
Relating to the submission of certain reports by the Health and Human Services Commission.

HB 3985 Raney
Relating to an insurer's obligation under a preferred provider benefit plan for continuity of care for certain Medicaid recipients.

HB 4075 Romero, Jr.
Relating to the regulation of certain occupations by the Texas Behavioral Health Executive Council; authorizing fees.

Relating to requiring the Department of Family and Protective Services to adopt a process to allow a foster parent to donate a foster care payment to the department.

Relating to enforcement actions taken against a child-care or child-placing agency administrator's license.

Relating to the office of the state long-term care ombudsman.

HB 4233 Zwiener
Relating to training regarding runaway prevention for certain individuals who provide care for children in the conservatorship of the Department of Family and Protective Services.

HB 4351 Noble
Relating to the training program required for certain employees of the Department of Family and Protective Services.

HB 4627 Klick | et al.
Relating to the alternative electronic visit verification system recognized under Medicaid.

HB 4629 Klick
Relating to the terms and qualifications of members on the Intellectual and Developmental Disability System Redesign Advisory Committee.

HB 4694 Noble
Relating to certain conferences, training, and continuing education provided by the Health and Human Services Commission or required of commission staff, commission surveyors, or staff of certain facilities regulated by the commission.

HB 4696 Noble
Relating to transferring certain investigations of abuse, neglect, and exploitation to the Health and Human Services Commission and the on-site investigation and survey of certain providers by the Health and Human Services Commission.
