Relating to a pilot program to increase the financial independence of foster youth who are transitioning to independent living.

HB 3765 Bucy
Relating to the establishment of a supply of luggage by the Department of Family and Protective Services for the transport of the personal belongings of a foster child.

HB 4110 Guillen
Relating to certain administrative penalties and procedures associated with aging, community-based, and long-term care service providers.

HB 4138 Schatzline | et al.
Relating to the establishment of the Texas Adoption Assistance Program.

HB 4157 Gervin-Hawkins
Relating to the notification of certain persons concerning certain events related to children in the managing conservatorship of the Department of Family and Protective Services.

HB 4201 Ramos
Relating to recording the results of certain home studies performed by the Department of Family and Protective Services.

HB 4267 Klick
Relating to the procedures for removing names from the central registry of child abuse and neglect.

HB 4269 Klick
Relating to the procedures and notice required before an individual's name is added to the central child abuse or neglect registry.

HB 4702 Campos
Relating to peer support specialists for individuals with an intellectual or developmental disability and peer services for those individuals under Medicaid living outside of state supported living centers.

HB 4888 Hefner
Relating to Medicaid coverage and reimbursement for non-opioid treatments.

HB 4905 Campos
Relating to the definition of neglect of a child and suits affecting the parent-child relationship in which the Department of Family and Protective Services central is appointed joint managing conservator with the parent.

HB 4956 Shaheen
Relating to monthly reports of certain activity of the Department of Family and Protective Services.

HB 5021 Guerra
Relating to requiring Health and Human Services Commission contractors to report certain information regarding subcontractors.

HB 5023 Guerra
Relating to requiring Medicaid managed care organizations to provide an annual bonus payment to certain Medicaid providers.
