Relating to the establishment of the vulnerable adult protection task force.

Relating to the process for recovering overpayments under Medicaid.

Relating to emancipation and extended foster care for certain older youth and young adults within the jurisdiction of court in a suit affecting the parent child relationship involving the Department of Family and Protective Services.

Relating to the development of a language access plan to increase access to assistance under health and human services programs by certain individuals.

Relating to Medicaid coverage and reimbursement for certain inpatient mental health services.

Relating to the expedited credentialing of providers under the Medicaid managed care program.

Relating to the powers and duties of the Health and Human Services Commission and the transfer to the commission of certain powers and duties from the Department of Family and Protective Services.

Relating to certain procedures relating to children placed under a parental child safety placement.

Relating to fraud prevention under certain health care programs.

SB 1849 Kolkhorst | et al.
Relating to an interagency reportable conduct search engine, standards for a person's removal from the employee misconduct registry and eligibility for certification as certain Texas Juvenile Justice Department officers and employees, and the Department of Family and Protective Services' use of certain information to conduct background checks.
