Relating to the applicability of certain laws regarding the occupational licensing of individuals with criminal convictions to the licensing of certain long-term health care facility personnel.

SB 956 LaMantia | et al.
Relating to repealing the coordinated strategic plan for health and human services in this state, including related conforming amendments.

SB 1629 Kolkhorst | et al.
Relating to the regulation of certain nursing facilities, including
licensing requirements and Medicaid participation requirements.

SB 2260 Blanco
Relating to management review of certain investigations conducted by the
Department of Family and Protective Services.
