Relating to an exemption to the cancellation of a water right for nonuse.

Relating to notice provided by a public water system regarding a water outage in an area served by a provider of fire protection services.

Relating to the disbursement of money by a levee improvement district.

Relating to late payment fees charged by a municipally owned water utility.

Relating to the disposition of certain property by the former Bois D'Arc Island Levee Improvement District of Dallas and Kaufman Counties and the record of dissolution of that district.

Relating to the regulation of water well drillers and water well pump installers.

Relating to the procedure for resolving certain customer complaints before the Public Utility Commission of Texas.

Relating to the authorization of disbursements by the board of directors of the North Harris County Regional Water Authority.

Relating to the procedure by which a regional water planning group is required to provide notice of certain public meetings or hearings.

Relating to the consideration of water markets in the regional water planning process.

Relating to an interim study of the financing of regional projects and facilities to convert from groundwater to surface water.

HB 4856 Darby
Relating to the use of recycled fluid oil and gas waste.

HB 4874 Bailes
Relating to notice of a water right amendment filed with the Texas Commission on Environmental Quality regarding a change in purpose of use.

HB 5318 Metcalf
Relating to the creation of the Montgomery County Water Control and Improvement District No. 6; granting a limited power of eminent domain; providing authority to issue bonds; providing authority to impose assessments, fees, and taxes.

HB 5334 Harless
Relating to the creation of the Cypress Creek Drainage Improvement District.

HCR 77 Kuempel
Designating November as Texas Wildlife and Conservation Month for a 10-year period beginning in 2023.

Recognizing the Texas Hill Country as an integral part of the State of Texas.

Proposing a constitutional amendment providing for the dedication of certain sales and use tax revenue to a special fund established in the state treasury to pay for water infrastructure in this state.
