Relating to requiring parental consent for psychological or psychiatric examination, testing, or treatment conducted by a school district employee.

HB 1926 Hull
Relating to the expiration date of the supplemental special education services program.

HB 2102 Goldman
Relating to the establishment of a new open-enrollment charter school campus by certain charter holders and to the expansion of an open-enrollment charter school.

HB 2120 Bell, Keith | et al.
Relating to the practice of barbering and cosmetology at an establishment at a public secondary school.

HB 2125 Bucy
Relating to a required training course for persons serving as special education representatives and hearing officers at impartial due process hearings or as facilitators for individualized education program facilitation.

HB 2273 Oliverson
Relating to the foundation curriculum and social studies curriculum in public schools.

HB 2510 Cain | et al.
Relating to transparency in certain legal proceedings and contracts involving a school district and a limit on legal fees that may be spent by a school district in certain legal proceedings.

HB 2808 VanDeaver
Relating to the finality of public school accountability determinations.

HB 3202 Noble | et al.
Relating to access by the Texas Education Agency and private schools to certain criminal history records.

HB 3303 Guerra
Relating to the establishment of a dual language immersion bilingual education teaching certificate.

HB 3315 Bell, Keith | et al.
Relating to a school district's grievance procedure regarding complaints concerning violation of parental rights.

HB 3908 Wilson | et al.
Relating to fentanyl prevention and drug poisoning awareness education for public school students in grades 6 through 12.

HB 3991 Isaac | et al.
Relating to Texas Fruit and Vegetable Day in public schools.

HB 4070 Schaefer
Relating to the punishment for trafficking of persons, online solicitation of a minor, and prostitution and to the dissemination of certain information, including the required posting of certain signs, regarding human trafficking.

HB 4342 Plesa
Relating to courses in personal finance literacy and economics for high school students in public schools.

HB 4375 VanDeaver
Relating to instruction in cardiopulmonary resuscitation and the use of an automated external defibrillator in public schools.

HB 4460 Gervin-Hawkins
Relating to the transfer for an athletic participation purpose of a student from the school district of the student's residence to another district.

HB 4477 Landgraf
Relating to the scheduling of University Interscholastic League competitions.

HB 4690 Dutton
Relating to the grievance procedure used by public schools to address complaints by students or parents.

Relating to the referral of certain students receiving special education services to a local intellectual and developmental disability authority for services or public benefits.
