HB 4752 Gervin-Hawkins | et al.
Relating to a study conducted by the Texas Historical Commission regarding the repair and renovation of Rosenwald school structures located in the south central region of this state.

HB 5248 Zwiener | et al. Posting Rule Suspended
Relating to the establishment of a task force to provide recommendations for the repatriation and disposition of Indigenous objects held by state institutions and agencies.

HCR 5 Moody
Authorizing the State Preservation Board to approve and permit the construction of a monument at the state Capitol Complex honoring the victims of mass shootings.

HCR 29 Leo-Wilson | et al.
Designating the second to last week in April as Texas Christian Heritage Week for a 10-year period ending in 2033.

HCR 80 Lalani
Designating the month of May as Muslim Heritage Month for a 10-year period beginning in 2024.

HCR 91 Oliverson | et al.
Authorizing the State Preservation Board to approve the construction of a replica of the National Life Monument at the State Capitol Complex.

HCR 104 Slawson
Designating Granbury as the official Celebration Capital of Texas for a 10-year period ending in 2033.

HCR 105 Harris, Cody
Designating Palestine as the official Dogwood Trails Capital of Texas for a 10-year period ending in 2033.

SB 811 Kolkhorst

Relating to disclosure of certain information by the Parks and Wildlife Department or the Texas Animal Health Commission.

SB 1032 Kolkhorst

Relating to oyster certificates of location; authorizing a fee.
