SB 287 Huffman | et al.
Relating to the prosecution of the offense of terroristic threat.

SB 402 Whitmire
Relating to the preference given by trial courts to hearings and trials for murder and capital murder offenses.

SB 645 Huffman
Relating to the criminal penalties for certain controlled substance offenses; increasing a criminal penalty.

SB 1004 Huffman
Relating to creating the criminal offense of tampering with an electronic monitoring device.

SB 1318 Huffman
Relating to the release of defendants on bail, the duties of a magistrate in certain criminal proceedings, and the appointment of certain criminal law hearing officers; creating a criminal offense.

SB 1319 Huffman
Relating to the reporting of certain overdose information and the mapping of overdoses for public safety purposes.

SJR 44 Huffman | et al.
Proposing a constitutional amendment authorizing the denial of bail under some circumstances to a person accused of a violent or sexual offense or of continuous trafficking of persons and requiring a judge or magistrate to impose the least restrictive conditions of bail that may be necessary to ensure the person's appearance in court as required and the safety of the community, law enforcement, and the victim of the alleged offense.
