9	ordinance, regulation, or other measure that prohibits or precludes
10	the designation of a school crossing zone or school crosswalk at a

high school campus that is located in a municipality with a

12 population of two million or more.

- 5 (2) In SECTION 1 of the bill, strike added Section
- 6 542.203(d), Transportation Code (page 1, lines 26-30), and
- 7 substitute the following:
- 8 (d) A local authority's standards, policies, orders,
- 9 ordinances, regulations, or other measures that designate a school
- 10 crossing zone or school crosswalk must include a high school campus
- 11 that is located in a municipality with a population of two million
- 12 or more.
- (e) On request of an administrator of a high school campus
- 14 described by Subsection (d), a local authority shall determine the
- 15 components, including any engineering report, necessary to
- 16 designate a school crossing zone or school crosswalk at the campus
- 17 and shall make the designation. This subsection does not apply to a
- 18 high school campus undergoing major expansion or new construction
- 19 that requires the preparation of a traffic impact analysis as part
- 20 of the permitting process.
- 21 (3) Add the following appropriately numbered SECTION to the
- 22 bill and renumber subsequent SECTIONS of the bill accordingly:
- SECTION \_\_\_\_. Not later than September 1, 2023, a local
- 24 authority described by Section 542.203(d), Transportation Code, as
- 25 added by this Act, shall:
- 26 (1) update all applicable school zone standards,
- 27 policies, orders, ordinances, and regulations to comply with that
- 28 section; and
- (2) post the updates described by Subdivision (1) of

- 1 this section on a publicly accessible Internet website with clear
- 2 instructions describing the process by which a designation request
- 3 may be made under Section 542.203(e), Transportation Code, as added
- 4 by this Act.
