#### A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to pedestrian use of a sidewalk.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 552.006(b), Transportation Code, is
5	repealed.
6	SECTION 2. The repeal by this Act of Section 552.006(b),
7	Transportation Code, does not apply to an offense committed before
8	the effective date of the repeal. An offense committed before the
9	effective date of the repeal is governed by the law as it existed on
10	the date the offense was committed, and the former law is continued
11	in effect for that purpose. For purposes of this section, an
12	offense was committed before the effective date of the repeal if any
13	element of the offense occurred before that date.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

- 2 below the enacting clause and substituting the following:
- 3 SECTION 1. Section 552.006(b), Transportation Code, is
- 4 amended to read as follows:
- 5 (b) If a sidewalk is not provided, a pedestrian walking along
- 6 and on a highway shall [if possible] walk on [:
- 7 (1)] the left side of the roadway [;] or
- 8 [(2)] the shoulder of the highway facing oncoming
- 9 traffic, unless the left side of the roadway or the shoulder of
- 10 the highway facing oncoming traffic is obstructed.
- 11 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 12 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this
- 13 Act. An offense committed before the effective date of this Act
- 14 is governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was
- 15 committed, and the former law is continued in effect for that
- 16 purpose. For purposes of this section, an offense was committed
- 17 before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense
- 18 occurred before that date.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.
