H.B. No. 3099

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to the designation of a portion of U.S. Highway 380 in Wise and Jack Counties as the Lost Battalion Memorial Highway.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Section 225.217 to read as follows:

Sec. 225.217. LOST BATTALION MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a) The portion of U.S. Highway 380 in Wise and Jack Counties between its intersection with U.S. Highway 281 and its intersection with U.S. Highway 287 is designated as the Lost Battalion Memorial Highway.

(b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

(1) design and construct markers indicating the designation as the Lost Battalion Memorial Highway and any other appropriate information; and

(2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,  
6 is amended by adding Section 225.217 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 225.217. LOST BATTALION MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a) The  
8 portion of U.S. Highway 380 in Wise and Jack Counties between its  
9 intersection with U.S. Highway 281 and its intersection with County  
10 Road 3001 is designated as the Lost Battalion Memorial Highway. The  
11 designation is in addition to any other designation.

12 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

13 (1) design and construct markers indicating the

15 appropriate information; and

16 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at
