H.B. No. 3672

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to the designation of portions of the state highway system as memorial highways for certain deceased peace officers.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 225.092(a), Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:

(a) Notwithstanding Section 225.001(c), the portion of Business U.S. Highway 281-S in the municipal limits of Premont [~~281 in Jim Wells County between its intersection with Farm-to-Market Road 716 and its intersection with County Road 422~~] is designated as the Lt. General Marc Cisneros Highway. The designation is in addition to any other designation.

SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Sections 225.217, 225.218, 225.219, 225.220, 225.221, 225.222, 225.223, 225.224, and 225.225 to read as follows:

Sec. 225.217. TROOPER RUSSELL LYNN BOYD MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

(a) The portion of State Highway 159 in the municipal limits of Hempstead is designated as the Trooper Russell Lynn Boyd Memorial Highway. The designation is in addition to any other designation.

(b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

(1) design and construct markers indicating the designation as the Trooper Russell Lynn Boyd Memorial Highway and any other appropriate information; and

(2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at

1 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

2 Sec. 225.218. RANGER STANLEY K. GUFFEY MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

3 (a) The portion of U.S. Highway 87 in the municipal limits of Brady  
4 is designated as the Ranger Stanley K. Guffey Memorial Highway. The  
5 designation is in addition to any other designation.

6 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

7 (1) design and construct markers indicating the  
8 designation as the Ranger Stanley K. Guffey Memorial Highway and  
9 any other appropriate information; and

10 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at  
11 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

12 Sec. 225.219. TROOPER MILTON ALEXANDER MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

13 (a) The portion of Interstate Highway 35 in the municipal limits of  
14 Hillsboro is designated as the Trooper Milton Alexander Memorial  
15 Highway. The designation is in addition to any other designation.

16 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

17 (1) design and construct markers indicating the  
18 designation as the Trooper Milton Alexander Memorial Highway and  
19 any other appropriate information; and

20 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at  
21 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

22 Sec. 225.220. TROOPER ERNESTO ALANIS MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a)

23 The portion of Interstate Highway 2 in the municipal limits of  
24 McAllen is designated as the Trooper Ernesto Alanis Memorial  
25 Highway. The designation is in addition to any other designation.

26 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

27 (1) design and construct markers indicating the

1 designation as the Trooper Ernesto Alanis Memorial Highway and any  
2 other appropriate information; and

3 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at  
4 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

5 Sec. 225.221. TROOPER HOLLIS S. LACY MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a)  
6 The portion of U.S. Highway 377 in the municipal limits of Denton is  
7 designated as the Trooper Hollis S. Lacy Memorial Highway. The  
8 designation is in addition to any other designation.

9 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

10 (1) design and construct markers indicating the  
11 designation as the Trooper Hollis S. Lacy Memorial Highway and any  
12 other appropriate information; and

13 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at  
14 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

15 Sec. 225.222. TROOPER HOWARD JORDAN MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a)  
16 The portion of U.S. Highway 67 in the municipal limits of Texarkana  
17 is designated as the Trooper Howard Jordan Memorial Highway. The  
18 designation is in addition to any other designation.

19 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

20 (1) design and construct markers indicating the  
21 designation as the Trooper Howard Jordan Memorial Highway and any  
22 other appropriate information; and

23 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at  
24 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

25 Sec. 225.223. TROOPER MARK FREDERICK MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a)  
26 The portion of eastbound Interstate Highway 10 in Austin County  
27 between mile marker 712 and mile marker 726 is designated as the

1 Trooper Mark Frederick Memorial Highway. The designation is in  
2 addition to any other designation.

3 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

4 (1) design and construct markers indicating the  
5 designation as the Trooper Mark Frederick Memorial Highway and any  
6 other appropriate information; and

7 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at  
8 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

9 Sec. 225.224. TROOPER WILLIAM KOHLLEPPEL MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

10 (a) The portion of westbound Interstate Highway 10 in Austin County  
11 between mile marker 712 and mile marker 726 is designated as the  
12 Trooper William Kohlleppe Memorial Highway. The designation is in  
13 addition to any other designation.

14 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

15 (1) design and construct markers indicating the  
16 designation as the Trooper William Kohlleppe Memorial Highway and  
17 any other appropriate information; and

18 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at  
19 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

20 Sec. 225.225. PATROLMAN BILLY D. HOWRY MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

21 (a) The portion of Interstate Highway 35 in Williamson County  
22 between mile marker 268 and mile marker 272 is designated as the  
23 Patrolman Billy D. Howry Memorial Highway. The designation is in  
24 addition to any other designation.

25 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

26 (1) design and construct markers indicating the  
27 designation as the Patrolman Billy D. Howry Memorial Highway and

1 any other appropriate information; and

2 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at  
3 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2023.

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

relating to the designation of portions of the state highway system as memorial highways for certain deceased peace officers.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

SECTION 1. Section 225.092(a), Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:

(a) Notwithstanding Section 225.001(c), the portion of Business U.S. Highway 281-S in the municipal limits of Premont [~~281 in Jim Wells County between its intersection with Farm-to-Market Road 716 and its intersection with County Road 422~~] is designated as the Lt. General Marc Cisneros Highway. The designation is in addition to any other designation.

SECTION 2. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code, is amended by adding Sections 225.217, 225.218, 225.219, 225.220, 225.221, 225.222, 225.223, 225.224, and 225.225 to read as follows:

Sec. 225.217. TROOPER RUSSELL LYNN BOYD MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

(a) The portion of U.S. Highway 290 in Waller County between its intersection with the Waller-Harris county line and its intersection with State Highway 6 is designated as the Trooper Russell Lynn Boyd Memorial Highway. The designation is in addition to any other designation.

(b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

(1) design and construct markers indicating the designation as the Trooper Russell Lynn Boyd Memorial Highway and

1 any other appropriate information; and

2 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at  
3 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

4 Sec. 225.218. RANGER STANLEY K. GUFFEY MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

5 (a) The portion of U.S. Highway 87 in the municipal limits of Brady  
6 is designated as the Ranger Stanley K. Guffey Memorial Highway. The  
7 designation is in addition to any other designation.

8 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

9 (1) design and construct markers indicating the  
10 designation as the Ranger Stanley K. Guffey Memorial Highway and  
11 any other appropriate information; and

12 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at  
13 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

14 Sec. 225.219. TROOPER MILTON ALEXANDER MEMORIAL HIGHWAY.

15 (a) The portion of Interstate Highway 35 in the municipal limits of  
16 Hillsboro is designated as the Trooper Milton Alexander Memorial  
17 Highway. The designation is in addition to any other designation.

18 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

19 (1) design and construct markers indicating the  
20 designation as the Trooper Milton Alexander Memorial Highway and  
21 any other appropriate information; and

22 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at  
23 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

24 Sec. 225.220. TROOPER ERNESTO ALANIS MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a)

25 The portion of Interstate Highway 2 in the municipal limits of  
26 McAllen is designated as the Trooper Ernesto Alanis Memorial  
27 Highway. The designation is in addition to any other designation.

1           (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

2                   (1) design and construct markers indicating the  
3 designation as the Trooper Ernesto Alanis Memorial Highway and any  
4 other appropriate information; and

5                   (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at  
6 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

7           Sec. 225.221. TROOPER HOLLIS S. LACY MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a)

8 The portion of U.S. Highway 377 in the municipal limits of Denton is  
9 designated as the Trooper Hollis S. Lacy Memorial Highway. The  
10 designation is in addition to any other designation.

11           (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

12                   (1) design and construct markers indicating the  
13 designation as the Trooper Hollis S. Lacy Memorial Highway and any  
14 other appropriate information; and

15                   (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at  
16 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

17           Sec. 225.222. TROOPER HOWARD JORDAN MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a)

18 The portion of U.S. Highway 67 in the municipal limits of Texarkana  
19 is designated as the Trooper Howard Jordan Memorial Highway. The  
20 designation is in addition to any other designation.

21           (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

22                   (1) design and construct markers indicating the  
23 designation as the Trooper Howard Jordan Memorial Highway and any  
24 other appropriate information; and

25                   (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at  
26 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

27           Sec. 225.223. TROOPER MARK FREDERICK MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a)

1 The portion of Interstate Highway 10 in Austin County between its  
2 intersection with the Austin-Waller county line and its  
3 intersection with State Highway 36 is designated as the Trooper  
4 Mark Frederick Memorial Highway. The designation is in addition to  
5 any other designation.

6 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

7 (1) design and construct markers indicating the  
8 designation as the Trooper Mark Frederick Memorial Highway and any  
9 other appropriate information; and

10 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at  
11 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

12 Sec. 225.224. TROOPER WILLIAM KOHLLEPPEL III MEMORIAL  
13 HIGHWAY. (a) The portion of Interstate Highway 10 in Austin County  
14 between its intersection with State Highway 36 and its intersection  
15 with the Austin-Colorado county line is designated as the Trooper  
16 William Kohlleppel III Memorial Highway. The designation is in  
17 addition to any other designation.

18 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

19 (1) design and construct markers indicating the  
20 designation as the Trooper William Kohlleppel III Memorial Highway  
21 and any other appropriate information; and

22 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at  
23 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.

24 Sec. 225.225. TROOPER BILLY D. HOWRY MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a)  
25 The portion of Interstate Highway 35 in Williamson County between  
26 mile marker 268 and mile marker 272 is designated as the Trooper  
27 Billy D. Howry Memorial Highway. The designation is in addition to

1 any other designation.

2 (b) Subject to Section 225.021(c), the department shall:

3 (1) design and construct markers indicating the  
4 designation as the Trooper Billy D. Howry Memorial Highway and any  
5 other appropriate information; and

6 (2) erect a marker at each end of the highway and at  
7 appropriate intermediate sites along the highway.
