(a) from money appropriated by this Act, the claim or judgment must be 4 5 verified and substantiated by the administrator of the special fund or account against which the claim or judgment is to be charged and 6 be approved by the attorney general and the comptroller of public 7 8 accounts. Any claim or judgment itemized in this Act that has not been verified and substantiated by the administrator of the special 9 10 fund or account and approved by the attorney general and the comptroller by August 31, 2025, may not be paid from money 11 12 appropriated by this Act.

- Each claim or judgment paid from money appropriated by 13 14 this Act must contain such information as the comptroller of public 15 accounts requires but at a minimum must contain the specific reason for the claim or judgment. If the claim is for a void warrant, the 16 17 claim must include a specific identification of the services, refunds, or other items for which the warrant was 18 19 originally issued. In addition, it must include a certification by 20 the original payee or the original payee's successors, heirs, or assigns that the debt is still outstanding. If the claim or 21 judgment is for unpaid goods or services, it must be accompanied by 22 23 an invoice or other acceptable documentation of the unpaid account 24 and any other information that may be required by the comptroller.
- SECTION 6. Subject to the conditions and restrictions in this Act and provisions stated in the judgments, the comptroller of public accounts is authorized and directed to issue one or more

- 2 effective date of this Act, in favor of each of the individuals,
- 3 firms, or corporations named or claim numbers identified in this
- 4 Act, in an amount not to exceed the amount set opposite their
