- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 ARTICLE I
- 7 SECTION 1. (a) The members of the United States House of
- 8 Representatives from the State of Texas are elected from the
- 9 districts described by Article II of this Act.
- 10 (b) One member is elected from each district established by
- 11 this Act.
- 12 ARTICLE II
- 13 SECTION 1. The districts for members of the United States
- 14 House of Representatives from the State of Texas are as described by
- 15 PLANC2308 on the redistricting computer system operated by the
- 16 Texas Legislative Council.
- 17 ARTICLE III
- SECTION 1. In this Act, "tract," "block group," and "block"
- 19 mean the geographic areas identified by those terms on the 2020
- 20 Census TIGER/Line Shapefiles, prepared by the federal Bureau of the
- 21 Census for the Twenty-fourth Decennial Census of the United States,
- 22 enumerated as of April 1, 2020.
- 23 SECTION 2. It is the intention of the Texas Legislature
- 24 that, if any county, tract, block group, block, or other geographic

- 1 area has erroneously been left out of this Act, a court reviewing
- 2 this Act should include that area in the appropriate district in
- 3 accordance with the intent of the legislature, using any available
- 4 evidence of that intent, including evidence such as that used by the
- 5 Supreme Court of Texas in Smith v. Patterson, 111 Tex. 535, 242 S.W.
- 6 749 (1922).
- 7 SECTION 3. (a) This Act supersedes all previous enactments
- 8 or orders adopting congressional districts for the State of Texas.
- 9 All previous acts of the legislature adopting congressional
- 10 districts for the State of Texas are repealed.
- 11 (b) Chapter 7 (S.B. 6), Acts of the 87th Legislature, 3rd
- 12 Called Session, 2021, is repealed.
- 13 SECTION 4. The districts described by Article II of this Act
- 14 apply to the election of the members of the United States House of
- 15 Representatives from the State of Texas beginning with the primary
- 16 and general elections in 2026 for members of the 120th Congress.
- 17 This Act does not affect the membership or congressional districts
- 18 of the 119th Congress.
- 19 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 24 legislative session.
