## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to a requirement that the ballot for an election to amend the state constitution include an estimate of the fiscal impact to 3 the state of the proposed amendment. 4 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 6 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 274.001, Election Code, is amended to read as follows: 7 Sec. 274.001. FORM OF AMENDMENT ON BALLOT; COST ESTIMATE. 8 9 SECTION 2. Section 274.001, Election Code, is amended by adding Subsection (d) to read as follows: 10 (d) For each proposition submitting a proposed 11 12 constitutional amendment, the secretary of state shall prepare for placement on the ballot one of the following statements, as 13 14 applicable: (1) if the Legislative Budget Board determines the 15 16 constitutional amendment to have a recurring cost under Section 314.001(b), Government Code: "Subject to future legislative 17 actions, the Legislative Budget Board estimates that the 18 implementation of this constitutional amendment would incur an 19 annual (insert "cost of" or "savings of", as applicable, and the 20 estimate determined under Section 314.001(b), Government Code) to 21 the state over (insert number of years determined under Section 22 23 314.001(b), Government Code)."; or 24 (2) if the Legislative Budget Board determines the

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constitutional amendment to have a one-time cost under Section 1 314.001(b), Government Code: "Subject to future legislative 2 actions, the Legislative Budget Board estimates that the 3 implementation of this constitutional amendment would have a 4 one-time (insert "cost of" or "savings of", as applicable, and the 5 estimate determined under Section 314.001(b), Government Code) to 6 the state.". 7 8 SECTION 3. Section 274.003(a), Election Code, is amended to read as follows: 9 10 (a) For each proposed constitutional amendment, the secretary of state shall certify in writing for placement on the 11 12 ballot: (1) the wording of the proposition submitting the 13 14 amendment; [and] 15 (2) the statement for the cost estimate prepared for the proposition under Section 274.001(d); and 16 17 (3) the proposition's number. SECTION 4. Section 314.001, Government Code, is amended to 18 read as follows: 19 Sec. 314.001. SYSTEM OF FISCAL NOTES. (a) The Legislative 20 Budget Board shall establish a system of fiscal notes identifying 21 the probable costs of each bill or resolution that authorizes or 22 23 requires the expenditure or diversion of state funds for a purpose 24 other than one provided for in the general appropriations bill. (b) This subsection applies only to a joint resolution to 25 26 amend the constitution. As soon as practicable after the time for gubernatorial action has expired under Section 14, Article IV, 27

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23 Code, as added by this Act.

SECTION 6. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to a ballot for an election on a proposed constitutional amendment ordered on or after the effective date of this Act. An election on a proposed constitutional amendment ordered before the effective

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1 date of this Act is governed by the law in effect when the election 2 was ordered, and the former law is continued in effect for that 3 purpose.

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4 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the 5 last day of the legislative session.
