AN ACT

- 2 relating to the authority of a political subdivision to propose for
- 3 voter approval the issuance of general obligation bonds for a
- 4 purpose rejected by voters at a bond election held during the
- 5 preceding five years.

- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Chapter 1253, Government Code, is amended by
- 8 adding Section 1253.0015 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 1253.0015. LIMITATION ON AUTHORITY TO PROPOSE ISSUANCE
- 10 OF GENERAL OBLIGATION BONDS. A political subdivision may not
- 11 submit a proposition to approve the issuance of general obligation
- 12 bonds to the voters if the political subdivision submitted a
- 13 proposition to approve the issuance of such bonds to the voters for
- 14 the same purpose within the preceding five years and the voters
- 15 failed to approve the proposition.
- 16 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 17 to a proposition submitted to voters for which the election was
- 18 ordered on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 23 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 24 legislative session.
