A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to electronic voter registration.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 13, Election Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 13.009 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 13.009. ELECTRONIC VOTER REGISTRATION. (a) The
7	secretary of state shall work with the Department of Public Safety
8	and the Department of Information Resources to implement a program
9	to allow a person to complete a voter registration application
10	over the Internet from the official website of this state. The
11	Internet websites of the secretary of state and the Department of
12	Public Safety must also provide a link to the location of the
13	application on the official website of this state.
14	(b) An applicant for electronic voter registration who has
15	an unexpired driver's license or personal identification card
16	issued in this state must:
17	(1) attest to the truth of the information provided on
18	the application by affirmatively accepting the information as
19	true; and

1 (2) affirmatively consent to the use of the signature 2 on the applicant's driver's license or personal identification 3 card for voter registration purposes. (c) An applicant for electronic voter registration who does 4 5 not have an unexpired driver's license or personal identification 6 card issued in this state must: 7 (1) attest to the truth of the information provided on the application by affirmatively accepting the information as 8 true; and 9 (2) digitally sign the applicant's application before 10 submitting it electronically. 11 12 (d) For each application submitted under Subsection (b), the 13 program shall require that a digital copy of the applicant's 14 signature be obtained from the Department of Public Safety. 15 (e) A digital signature given as provided by secretary of 16 state rule meets the signature requirement under Section 17 13.002(b). An application submitted under this section is 18 considered for all purposes an application submitted by mail under 19 this title. 20 (f) The secretary of state shall adopt rules as necessary to implement this section, including rules to provide for additional 21 22 security measures necessary to ensure the accuracy and integrity 23 of applications submitted electronically.

1 (g) The rules adopted under Subsection (f) must require 2 that: 3 (1) the Internet website through which a person may 4 complete a voter registration application include a description of 5 the offense described by Section 13.007 in a conspicuous location on the website near the place where the person begins or submits 6 7 the application; and 8 (2) the state electronic Internet portal project be 9 used to authenticate the identity and address of a person who 10 submits an application electronically under this section. SECTION 2. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the 11 12 last day of the legislative session.
