1	AN ACT
2	relating to a statewide order issued by the commissioner of state
3	health services authorizing a pharmacist to dispense ivermectin.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 1001, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 1001.090 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 1001.090. STATEWIDE ORDER AUTHORIZING DISPENSING OF
8	IVERMECTIN. (a) The commissioner shall issue a statewide order
9	authorizing a licensed pharmacist to dispense ivermectin without a
10	health care practitioner's prescription order notwithstanding any
11	other law.
12	(b) The statewide order must include written, standardized
13	procedures or protocols for a pharmacist to follow when dispensing
14	ivermectin and require the pharmacist to provide each patient with
15	instructions on the proper use of ivermectin.
16	(c) Notwithstanding any other law, a pharmacist may
17	dispense ivermectin in accordance with the statewide order.
18	(d) Notwithstanding any other law, a pharmacist acting in a
19	reasonably prudent manner is not criminally or civilly liable or
20	subject to professional disciplinary action for dispensing
21	ivermectin in accordance with the statewide order.
22	(e) A pharmacist dispensing ivermectin in accordance with
23	the statewide order shall provide an annual written report in the
24	form and manner the department prescribes on the number of doses of

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1	ivermectin the pharmacist dispensed in accordance with the
2	statewide order in the preceding calendar year.
3	(f) The executive commissioner and the Texas State Board of
4	Pharmacy may adopt the rules necessary to implement this section.
5	(g) Notwithstanding any other law, the commissioner's
6	issuance of a statewide order under Subsection (a) may not be the
7	basis for criminal or civil liability against the commissioner or
8	disciplinary action by a licensing entity in this state that issues
9	a license to the commissioner.
0	SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date

10 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date 11 of this Act, the commissioner of state health services shall issue a 12 statewide order in accordance with Section 1001.090, Health and 13 Safety Code, as added by this Act.

SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the legislative session.

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
