2 (C) a suit for the trial of the right to property
3 valued at \$500 or more that has been levied on under a writ of

5 <u>(D) a suit for the recovery of real property</u>. 6 <u>(c-1) In addition to other assignments provided by law, a</u> 7 judge of the county court at law in Atascosa County is subject to 8 assignment under Chapter 74 to any district court in Atascosa 9 County. A county court at law judge assigned to a district court 10 may hear any matter pending in the district court.

(d) The judge of a county court at law shall be paid <u>as</u> provided by Section 25.0005 [a total annual salary set by the commissioners court at an amount that is not less than \$1,000 less than the total annual salary received by a district judge in the county. A district judge's or statutory county court judge's total annual salary does not include contributions and supplements paid by a county].

18 SECTION 2. Section 25.0092(a), Government Code, as amended 19 by this Act, applies only to a case filed or proceeding commenced on 20 or after the effective date of this Act. A case filed or proceeding 21 commenced before that date is governed by the law in effect on the 22 date the case was filed or the proceeding was commenced, and the 23 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the 25 last day of the legislative session.
