Section 25.1102(a), Government Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 In addition to the jurisdiction provided by Section (a) 25.0003 and other law, a county court at law in Hidalgo County has 8 concurrent jurisdiction with the district court in: 9 family law cases and proceedings; [and] 10 (1) 11 (2) civil cases; and 12 (3) criminal cases for an offense punishable as a state jail felony [in which the matter in controversy does not 13 14 exceed \$750,000, excluding interest, statutory or punitive damages and penalties, and attorney's fees and costs, as alleged on the page 15 of the petition]. 16 SECTION 2. Section 25.1102(a), Government Code, as amended 17 by this Act, applies only to an action filed in a county court at law 18 in Hidalgo County on or after the effective date of this Act. 19 An action filed in a county court at law in Hidalgo County before the 20 21 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the action was filed, and the former law is continued in effect 22 23 for that purpose.

24 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
