7	Sec. 418.0535. FLOODING DISASTER GUIDE. (a) The division,
8	in collaboration with the department and the emergency management
9	council established under Section 418.013, shall develop a guide on
10	preparing for and responding to a flood disaster for civic,
11	volunteer, and community organizations.
12	(b) The guide must provide a comprehensive approach to
13	preparing for and responding to a flooding disaster and include
14	information on:
15	(1) the impact of a flooding disaster on a community
16	and the best practices for community engagement in response to the
17	<u>disaster;</u>
18	(2) recommendations for minimizing casualties through
19	volunteer presence in the disaster area;
20	(3) the coordination of and access to assistance
21	resources, including trauma and support services, acute support
22	services, long-term support services, spiritual support services,
23	and family or victim assistance;
24	(4) long-term recovery and community resilience;

No. 108 (5) communication coordination, including strategies 1 2 to coordinate community response; 3 (6) training and preparation resources on flooding 4 disaster response; and 5 (7) preserving and restoring community cohesion and 6 public life after the disaster. 7 (c) The division shall post the guide on the division's 8 publicly available Internet website. 9 (d) The division, in collaboration with the department, may seek the advice and assistance of local governments, civic 10 organizations, volunteer organizations, and community leaders in 11 12 the development and revision of the guide. SECTION 2. Not later than April 1, 2026, the Texas Division 13 of Emergency Management shall post on the division's publicly 14 15 available Internet website a flooding disaster preparation and response guide, as required by Section 418.0535, Government Code, 16 17 as added by this Act. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the 18

last day of the legislative session.

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
