use of motor 1 (10)proper maintenance and safe 2 vehicles; safe buildings and physical facilities; 3 (11)4 (12) proper fire precautions; 5 (13)safe and proper recreational and other equipment; 6 (14) proper regard for density and use of the 7 premises; and 8 (15) records of criminal convictions of camp 9 personnel. (b) The executive commissioner by rule shall establish 10 minimum building standards for youth camps to minimize and prevent 11 flooding of a camp's buildings and other physical facilities 12 located within a 100-year floodplain or within five feet of a 13 14 100-year floodplain. 15 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 16 17 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 18 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the 19 legislative session. 20
