7	(b) The review committee is a multidisciplinary advisory

11	follows:
12	(A) four physicians specializing in obstetrics,
13	at least one of whom is a maternal fetal medicine specialist;
14	(B) one certified nurse-midwife;
15	(C) one registered nurse;
16	(D) one nurse specializing in labor and delivery;
17	(E) one physician specializing in family
18	<pre>practice;</pre>
19	(F) one physician specializing in psychiatry;
20	(G) one physician specializing in pathology;
21	(H) one epidemiologist, biostatistician, or
22	researcher of pregnancy-related deaths;
23	(I) one social worker or social service provider;
24	(J) two community members with experience in a

relevant health care field, including a field involving the 1 analysis of health care data, one of whom must represent an urban 2 3 area of this state and one of whom must represent a rural area of this state; 4 5 (K) one medical examiner or coroner responsible 6 for recording deaths; 7 one physician specializing in critical care; (L) 8 (M) one physician specializing in emergency 9 care; 10 (N) one physician specializing in cardiology; (0) 11 physician specializing in one 12 anesthesiology; (P) physician specializing 13 one in oncology; 14 [and] 15 (Q) representative one of а managed care 16 organization; and 17 (R) two doulas, one of whom must have experience providing care in an urban community, one of whom must have 18 experience providing care in a rural community, and at least one of 19 whom must specialize in end-of-life care; 20 21 (2) a representative of the department's family and community health programs; and 22 23 (3) the state epidemiologist for the department or the 24 epidemiologist's designee.

25 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date 26 of this Act, the commissioner of state health services shall 27 appoint members to the Texas Maternal Mortality and Morbidity

Review Committee in accordance with Section 34.002, Health and
Safety Code, as amended by this Act.
