## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

2	relating to creating a grant program administered by the Texas

4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Chapter 421, Government Code, is amended by
6	adding Subchapter G to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER G. TEXAS DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT HILL COUNTRY
8	2025 FLOOD RESPONSE GRANT PROGRAM
9	Sec. 421.121. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter:
10	(1) "Division" means Texas Division of Emergency
11	Management.
12	(2) "Chief" means the Chief of the Texas Division of
13	Emergency Management.
14	(3) "Local government" means a municipality, county,
15	special district or authority, or any other political subdivision
16	of this state.
17	Sec. 421.122. TEXAS DIVISION OF EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT HILL
18	COUNTRY 2025 FLOOD RESPONSE GRANT PROGRAM. (a) The Texas Division
19	of Emergency Management Hill Country Flood Response Grant Program
20	is established to:
21	(1) administer a grant program to assist local
22	governments with acquiring emergency communication equipment that
23	is interoperable with other emergency communication equipment and
24	infrastructure in this state and with constructing additional

- 1 emergency communication infrastructure to ensure that the first
- 2 responders of this state have access to equipment and
- 3 infrastructure that is interoperable to the extent necessary to
- 4 effectively communicate during an emergency.
- 5 Sec. 421.123. GRANT PROGRAM. (a) The Division shall
- 6 establish a grant program to provide grants to local governments
- 7 for the purchase of emergency communication equipment and
- 8 infrastructure, the construction of emergency communication
- 9 infrastructure, and the expenses of training employees of the local
- 10 government for the effective use of the equipment during an
- 11 emergency.
- 12 (b) To be eligible for a grant under the grant program, an
- 13 applicant must be a local government, submit a proposal to the
- 14 Division, and comply with the rules established by the Division for
- 15 the administration of the grant program.
- 16 <u>(c) The Chief shall establish procedures to administer the</u>
- 17 grant program, including:
- 18 (1) eligibility criteria for a grant recipient;
- 19 (2) guidelines relating to grant amounts; and
- 20 (3) procedures for submitting and evaluating
- 21 proposals.
- 22 (d) The Division shall enter into a contract that includes
- 23 performance requirements with each grant recipient. The Division
- 24 shall monitor and enforce the terms of the contract.
- 25 (e) The Division may require as a condition of a grant
- 26 awarded under this section that:
- 27 (1) the officers or employees of the recipient

- 1 successfully complete one or more training programs, as determined
- 2 by the Division, which may include incident command system
- 3 training; and
- 4 (2) the recipient adopt standardized procedures for
- 5 incident command or management.
- 6 Sec. 421.124. USES OF GRANT MONEY. Money awarded under the
- 7 grant program may be used only to:
- 8 (1) purchase emergency communication equipment,
- 9 including radios, spare parts, and accessories, for use by first
- 10 responders that is interoperable with the other emergency
- 11 communication equipment and infrastructure in this state or enables
- 12 interoperability;
- 13 (2) construct emergency communication infrastructure,
- 14 including radio towers, that is interoperable with the other
- 15 emergency communication equipment and infrastructure in this state
- 16 or enables interoperability, including the acquisition of land
- 17 necessary for the construction;
- 18 (3) cover the cost of adapting existing emergency
- 19 communication equipment or infrastructure to, or otherwise
- 20 integrating the equipment or infrastructure with, new emergency
- 21 communication equipment purchased or infrastructure constructed;
- 22 (4) cover the operational or maintenance cost of the
- 23 equipment or infrastructure described by Subdivision (1), (2), or
- 24 (3); or
- 25 (5) attend or provide the training to first responders
- 26 on the effective use of the equipment and infrastructure described
- 27 by Subdivisions (1), (2), and (3).

- 1 Sec. 421.125. GRANT PROGRAM FUNDING. The Division may use
- 2 any available funds to implement the grant program.
- 3 Sec. 421.126. GIFTS, GRANTS, AND DONATIONS. The Division
- 4 may accept gifts, grants, and donations from any source, including
- 5 private and nonprofit organizations, for the purpose of
- 6 <u>implementing this subchapter.</u>
- 7 Sec. 421.127. RULES. The Division may adopt rules to
- 8 <u>administer this subchapter.</u>
- 9 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
