2 relating to requiring certain alert messages to be in English and

3 Spanish.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 411.306, Government Code, is amended to

6 read as follows:

7 Sec. 411.306. CONTENT OF POWER OUTAGE ALERT. The power

8 outage alert must be in English and Spanish and include a statement

9 that electricity customers may experience a power outage.

10 SECTION 2. Section 411.352, Government Code, is amended to

11 read as follows:

12 Sec. 411.352. STATEWIDE AMERICA'S MISSING: BROADCAST

13 EMERGENCY RESPONSE (AMBER) ALERT SYSTEM FOR ABDUCTED CHILDREN AND

14 MISSING PERSONS WITH INTELLECTUAL DISABILITIES. With the

15 cooperation of the Texas Department of Transportation, the office

16 of the governor, and other appropriate law enforcement agencies in

17 this state, the department shall develop and implement a statewide

18 alert system to be activated on behalf of an abducted child or a

19 missing person with an intellectual disability. The department

20 shall require that the information provided through the alert

21 system, including information sent through text messages, be in

22 English and Spanish.

- 16 disease; and
- 17 (2) a statement instructing any person with
- 18 information related to the missing senior citizen or person with
- 19 Alzheimer's disease to contact a local law enforcement agency.
- SECTION 5. Section 411.448, Government Code, is amended to
- 21 read as follows:
- Sec. 411.448. CONTENT OF ALERT. The alert must be in
- 23 English and Spanish and include:
- 24 (1) all appropriate information that is provided by
- 25 the law enforcement agency under Section 411.446 and that may lead
- 26 to the apprehension of the missing suspect; and
- 27 (2) a statement instructing any person with

- 1 information related to the missing suspect to contact a law
- 2 enforcement agency.
- 3 SECTION 6. Section 411.468, Government Code, is amended to
- 4 read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 411.468. CONTENT OF ALERT. The alert must be in
- 6 English and Spanish and include:
- 7 (1) all appropriate information that may lead to the
- 8 safe recovery of the missing adult, as determined by the
- 9 department; and
- 10 (2) a statement instructing any person with
- 11 information related to the missing adult to contact a local or state
- 12 law enforcement agency.
- 13 SECTION 7. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 14 of this Act, the Department of Public Safety of the State of Texas
- 15 shall adopt rules to implement the changes in law made by this Act.
- SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2025.
