## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the allocation and deposit of certain surplus state
- 3 revenue to the property tax relief fund for use in reducing school
- 4 district maintenance and operations ad valorem taxes.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 403.109, Government Code, is amended by
- 7 adding Subsections (e) and (f) to read as follows:
- 8 (e) Not later than the 90th day after the last day of each
- 9 state fiscal biennium, the comptroller shall deposit to the credit
- 10 of the fund general revenue in an amount equal to one-half of the
- 11 amount by which the total available general revenue for that
- 12 biennium at the end of the biennium exceeds the amount of total
- 13 <u>available general revenue stated in the comptroller's biennial</u>
- 14 revenue estimate for that biennium.
- 15 (f) Notwithstanding any other provision of this section,
- 16 money deposited to the credit of the fund under Subsection (e) may
- 17 be appropriated only to the Texas Education Agency for use in
- 18 providing property tax relief through reduction of the state
- 19 compression percentage, as defined by Section 48.255, Education
- 20 Code.
- 21 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the state fiscal
- 22 biennium beginning September 1, 2027.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
- 24 last day of the legislative session.
