A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to a grant program to assist nonprofit organizations in
3	the provision of emergency communications services in this state.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 771, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 771.080 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 771.080. EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS SERVICES GRANT
8	PROGRAM. (a) From money appropriated or otherwise available for
9	the purpose, the commission shall establish and administer a grant
10	program to assist nonprofit organizations in the provision of
11	emergency communications services, including 9-1-1 service, to end
12	users in this state.
13	(b) The commission by rule shall:
14	(1) develop an application process for a nonprofit
15	organization applying for a grant under this section;
16	(2) develop eligibility and selection criteria for a
17	nonprofit organization applying for a grant under this section;
18	(3) develop procedures for commission approval of the
19	use of grant money awarded under this section; and
20	(4) establish accountability controls for grant
21	recipients to ensure the public purpose of providing emergency
22	communications services is accomplished and this state receives a
23	return benefit.

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(c) In addition to money appropriated by the legislature,

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- 1 the commission may accept gifts, grants, or donations from any
- 2 source to administer and finance the grant program established
- 3 <u>under this section.</u>
- 4 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date
- 5 of this Act, the Commission on State Emergency Communications shall
- 6 establish the emergency communications services grant program
- 7 required by Section 771.080, Health and Safety Code, as added by
- 8 this Act.
- 9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect on the 91st day after the
- 10 last day of the legislative session.
